VIOLATION OF THE CERTIFICATION AGREEMENT

We regret to inform you that although the ISO 22000:2005 certification awarded for the Food Safety Management System of your organization was withdrawn due to non-continuation of certification and the certificate has been returned to Ind-Expo, our logo is still being used by your organization.

We have observed this in your packets of Sprats sold in Food City outlets. It is a violation of the Certification Agreement as per Article 2 - General rights and obligations, which refers to Conditions for use of logo. Clause 16 of the Conditions for use of logo states that "Certified organizations shall immediately cease to use any materials or documentation containing the logo following withdrawal, suspension or termination of certification". A hard copy of the Conditions for use of logo and also a soft copy was given to you(CD) at the time of certification. Please see that the CD is returned to us at the earliest.


If you have any more material in stock you may affix a sticker over that and please bring a sample to us as evidence. However we shall monitor same in Supermarkets and if using our logo is still continued we will be compelled to take legal action against your organization.

In case Sri Lanka Accreditation Board observe that our logo is still being used by you legal action will be initiated immediately as your organization is no more in the Certified Client's list of the Ind-Expo web site.
